Our Story

In 2012, Jonathan Torchia had an idea – he wanted to create a fundraising event – a half marathon event that could attract a few hundred runners to support a local charity and raise awareness. Gathering his WFPS colleagues to form a Race Committee, they set about planning their small event and selected the Heart and Stroke Foundation as their charity of choice. Community response to this new event was overwhelming – all initial 500 spots sold out in two months, causing the committee to open up additional race spots and selling out a second time with 1,600 runners.

Fast forward to 2018, the event hosts 3,200 runners, 500 volunteers and has raised over \$300,000 in support of the Heart and Stroke Foundation! The Race Committee is a board of 24 volunteers, who bring amazing energy and enthusiasm to the event planning process.

As the Race Committee looks to the future they hope to continue to raise funds for the Heart and Stroke Foundation and seek out new ways to support the community all the while focused on maintaining a runner-centric event!
